[23/08/2015 16:47:44] Weekend Testing Europe: in fact with as few people as we have today, we could have used either of those, or the video sharing in this version of Skype

[23/08/2015 16:48:09] Richard Bradshaw: voice is key

[23/08/2015 16:48:10] Maaret Pyhäjärvi: Remote pairing is a skill and takes practice, good point.

[23/08/2015 16:48:23] Richard Bradshaw: tools are getting much better

[23/08/2015 16:48:28] Weekend Testing Europe: lets focus on these issues then...

[23/08/2015 16:53:13] Marine: I use Skype in the office to share screens, but I often experienced lagging screen that prevents from being "in the flow"

[23/08/2015 16:54:38] Maaret Pyhäjärvi: Sharing screen is in my experience very different from controlling the same screen. Lagging is problematic.

[23/08/2015 16:55:07] Marine: yes, controlling the same screen is way better to interact with your partner

[23/08/2015 16:55:42] Weekend Testing Europe: How are you getting on Linh?

[23/08/2015 16:55:43] Trisha agarwal: i found this tool: http://www.wiziq.com/online-class [23/08/2015 16:55:44] Christian Kram: a problem we sometimes have at work is that we are using customer's hardware and network, but only customers are allowed to do things like screensharing, external developers like us are forbidden because of security guidelines. this often makes collaborating hard. There have been moments when I preferred to drive 20km to work vis-a-vis instead of trying to collaborate online.

[23/08/2015 16:55:53] Trisha agarwal: which is nice, there is no screen lagging, with muntiple func to share the screen to

[23/08/2015 16:56:31] Marine: you have to be very explicit to drive your Partner to do the action you want her to do. It reminds me of an Agile game when you instruct someone to draw something; the results are usually hilarious

[23/08/2015 16:58:50] Weekend Testing Europe: I've found recently that in my organisation that there is a greater number of people remoting, but also pairing up remotely. I have done it with colleagues when I have have worked from home and vice versa...however there is always the issue of where remotes aren't included always in internal conversations.

[23/08/2015 16:59:03] Weekend Testing Europe: this is a separate issue from pairing however... [23/08/2015 16:59:26] Maaret Pyhäjärvi: The session was packed with stuff and we did not get through it all:

- Remote pairing with tools
- Strong-style pairing changing roles
- Analysing a new application by using it, documenting to a mindmap

[23/08/2015 17:00:41] Maaret Pyhäjärvi: It helps us share a common context for the task we are pairing on.

[23/08/2015 17:00:59] Weekend Testing Europe: I would imagine that would require a LOT of trust between testers pairing up...

[23/08/2015 17:01:13] Weekend Testing Europe: ?

[23/08/2015 17:01:17] Trisha agarwal: next weekend same time, if it works for you?

[23/08/2015 17:01:24] Maaret Pyhäjärvi: All pairing requires trust.
